## Violence Against Women/Gender justice

Many important aspects or developments in the society sometime require immediate attention to pave way for problem solving. This can be done only through activism by sensing the core issue concerned. Hence, violence against women and girl children are witnessed in the operational area, needful campaign and activity is immediately attended, possible interventions are done.

a) Sexual Abuse Against Girl Child: We believe that the brutal acts, in human, insensitive acts against girl children, like rape, exploiting her labor, physical violence are the results of discrimination, poverty, lack of security, oppression, and influence of negative audio and visual programs.

In this context we conduct awareness programs on the issue of girl child abuse, against child marriage, domestic labours, and helps girl children who are rape victim's and their families through legal, counseling, medical aid.

- **b)** Conduct suggestive sessions and provide legal aid counseling to women, and for men we take counseling sessions on the importance of the gender sensitivity and provide information on the laws and their impact on individuals lives.
- c) Community Panchayats: It is important to involve community in the issue of domestic violence, or family disturbances, as family is supported by community, and women as a team and group can focus attention on the problems of women with more confidence and take effective measures. So our organization identify women with leadership qualities and train them on issues where they can play a positive, gender sensitive role, while bargaining with the men folk within their community context.
